Duties and Responsibilities

- Required to use a variety of hand tools, power tools, bench tools and other equipment to perform required duties.
- Operate all equipment and utilize all tools in compliance with the safety standards of its operation and utilization.
- Assist in all aspects of grounds and roads maintenance to include but not be limited to snow removal, lawn mowing, planting, etc.
- Perform all duties in a manner in keeping with the safety of self and all others.
- Report all unsafe conditions to immediate supervisor in a timely and responsible manner.
- Utilize all substances on the job according to the MSDS guidelines for safe and proper utilization, and immediately bring any and all questions regarding such to direct supervisor.
- Become familiar with appropriate MSDS forms that relate to all substances used on the job.
- Attend mandatory in-services as directed.
- Maintain and foster positive working relationships with people in all areas.
- Perform other duties as assigned or as directed.

Qualifications

- Ability to read, write, and comprehend safe and proper use of chemicals, materials, and equipment used in performing one's responsibility.
- One year experience assisting in general maintenance field or trades required.
- Additional education and experience desired.
- Ability to work weekends desired.
- Must hold valid West Virginia Motor Vehicle Operator License.

Working Conditions/Physical Requirements

- Lifting/carrying of objects/items weighing up to 100 pounds for 20% of each shift.
